Midway Travel Assistance

Covid Protocol

US Speedskating will have a Covid-19 policy in place for all competitors and spectators. Further detail on this will be on the US Speedskating registration site.



Skaters that are planning on attending Age Pack Class Nationals:

The following is from ISU (Communication No. 2195), which states what is required for protective gear at all US Speedskating sanctioned long track mass start events.

All Competitors MUST wear:

- Cut-resistant racing suit or underwear
- Knee and shin guards, made of plastic or cut resistant material
- Cut resistant gloves
- Cut resistant neck and ankle protection
- A helmet that conforms to the shape of the head. The helmet shall comply with the technical specifications for Short Track Speed Skating as indicated in ISU Special Regulations for Short Track Speed Skating, Rule 291, paragraph 1.a).

Moreover, the front and back part of the blades must be rounded off, with a radius of 1 cm.

** The majority of our members competing at age class nationals already have the needed protective gear in order to compete (old Midway short track/cut-resistant suits). If you do not, and you plan on competing at age class nationals in a couple of weeks, please contact your coach immediately. We will try to assist in obtaining the proper equipment.

Skaters that are planning on attending USS Future of Speed Camp:

Midway skaters choosing to participate in the US Speedskating Future of Speed Camp do not need to have the full cut-resistant suits. They will, however, need to wear:

- Short Track Skates and Long Track Skates (Long Track Skates not required)
- Helmet
- Shin guards
- Neck guard

If you need help obtaining these items, please contact your coach immediately. Midway will try to assist in obtaining the proper equipment.
